## 3. COMPETITION RULES

### a) Format

The championships will be run as per AIBA Technical Rules and AOB Competition Rules.

- The Official Draw will be conducted by Swiss Timing through an electronic draw.
- One ring will be used until the finals phase.
- AOB Competition Format: Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes each, one (1) minute rest between rounds
- AIBA 10 points scoring system will be used
- Medals will be distributed to the first 4 boxers of each weigh category (1 Gold, 1 silver, 2 Bronze's).
- The Event will be officiated by an International Technical Officials and minimum one Stars level Referees and Judges, appointed by ASBC. The Supervisor of the event is Mrs. Karina Picson.

As an AIBA open competition, there will be General Weigh-in.

At the general weigh-in, your athlete (s) must present:

- Passport
- Record books with annual medical signed by doctor
- An Accreditation Card
- AIBA Medical certificate issued within the last 3 months
- Declaration of non-pregnancy for women boxers
- Red and Blue uniform

**4. REGISTRATIONS**

**a) Participating Boxers**

- The 2<sup>nd</sup> Indonesia Police Commissioner Cup Boxing Manado 2018 is an Open tournament.
- Only athletes who comply with the AIBA Constitution and Rules and its Bye-law are entitled to participate in this boxing competition.
- Boxer between the age of 19 and 40 according to their year of birth (born between January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1978 and December 31<sup>st</sup>, 1999) are eligible to participate in the competition.
- Only one boxer per weight category.

**b) Team Officials**

- Each Team are required to bring their team RJ with minimum AIBA 1-star.
- Each Team Delegation can have the following number of Team Officials:
  - 1 Team Manager
  - 1 Team RJ (min. AIBA 1-star)
  - 1 – 3 Boxers > 1 Coach
  - 4 – 6 Boxers > 2 Coaches
  - More than 7 Boxers > 3 Coaches

### c) Extra Officials

- Any additional people to the ones outlined in 4.b above, who the National Federation (NF) would send to work with the team or arriving & departing before/after the schedule would be registered as an Extra Official and must pay the organizer USD 110/pax/day.
- The extra officials that do not have a direct link with the preparation of the team for the competition will not receive an accreditation. Decisions will be taken by Host country organizer on a case by case basis.
- Team Delegation Extra-Officials
  - National Coach of a registered boxer
  - Physiotherapist
  - Doctor
  - Nutritionist
