2.2.Competition Officials

The Championships is an AOB 3-star Category A event and will be officiated by AIBA Certified International Technical Officials (ITO), AIBA 3 star Referees /Judges and AIBA Certified Coaches.

3.1.Participating Boxers

- Elite men boxers between the age of 19 and 40 according to their year of birth (born between January 1, 2000 December 31, 1979) will be eligible to compete in the following categories: 46 kg 49 kg, 52 kg, 56 kg, 60 kg, 64 kg, 69 kg, 75 kg, 81 kg, 91 kg, 91 + kg
- Elite women boxers between the age of 19 and 40 according to their year of birth (born between January 1, 2000 December 31, 1979) will be eligible to compete in the following categories: 45 kg 48 kg, 51 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 64 kg, 69 kg, 75 kg, 81 kg, 81 + kg
- Reserve Boxers : If your National Federation is hesitating between 2 boxers or more, or simply wants to prevent any injury, please use the "Reserve boxer" function in the database.
- This function will allow you to register more than one boxer in the same category, and you will have the possibility to choose last minute which boxer will participate even after registration ended (only one boxer will be allowed to compete in each category).

3.2.Team Officials

Each Team Delegation can have the following number of Team Officials:

- ▶ 1 Team Manager
- ➤ 1 Team Physician
- ➤ 1 Physiotherapist

Number of coaches according to below table:

- ➤ 1 boxer → Up to 3 coaches
- ▶ 2-3 boxers \rightarrow Up to 4 Coaches
- ▶ 4-7 Boxers \rightarrow Up to 5 Coaches
- ➢ 8-15 Boxers → Up to 8 Coaches
- ▶ 16-20 boxer → Up to 10 coaches

3.3. Coaches and R&J's

- > Each Boxer will be entitled to be accompanied to the ring by up to three (3) Coaches.
- > Only two (2) Coaches may mount the apron of the ring and only one (1) may enter the ring.
- > All boxers must be accompanied by at least one 1-star AIBA certified coach at ringside during the bouts.
- > All Coaches allowed to work in the Field of Play (FOP) must be AIBA certified (1 to 3-Star).
- If any team does not have a 1-Star coach, please raise this at the Technical Meeting so arrangements can be made with another team.
- \succ Any coach of National Level, who has not certified through AIBA, will not be allowed to enter the FOP.
- > All R&J's will be appointed by ASBC R&J Commission.

4.1.Process

The process for obtaining visa for Thailand will be as follows:

- > Team delegations who needs Visas must immediately request it to the Thailand Embassy / Consulate of their country.
- > LOC will provide landing visa letters for all Team Delegation who doesn't have Thailand Embassy / consulate in their own country.
- In this case please contact immediately Mr. Kraitach Kaewkate and provide him with valid passport copies of the applicant(s) before March 31.
- > Please note that after this deadline the LOC cannot granted any Visa

7.3.Payment conditions

- > Team Delegations must pay their full room charges as above for the entire Championships Period (April 16-27).
- > Only on-site payment in CASH by US Dollar will be accepted.
- > LOC will not be able to accept any other form of payment on site.
- Team Delegations will not be able to receive accreditation cards and hotel room keys if the payment is not made in full.

7.4.Meals

Three Meals per day will be served. The daily menus will be done according to the AIBA Dietary requirements. The Meal hours will be:

8.COMPETITION SYSTEM

- > The Championships will be run according to Current AIBA Technical Rules and AOB Competition Rules
- > There will be seeding for this event, according to the Appendix C of the Current AOB Competition Rules.
- > The Official Draw will be conducted by Swiss Timing through an electronic draw.
- > Two rings will be used for this competition.
- > The Scoring System will be based on a "Ten Point Must- System".
- > There will be five (5) Judges for each bout in accordance with electronic draw by AIBA Scoring System.

10.SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

10.1All Boxers must bring the following items to the Sport Entries Check :

- ➢ Boxers' passports
- ➢ Boxer's International Record Books
- > Boxer's AIBA Medical Certificate (issued within the last 3 months)
- Declaration of Non-Pregnancy (for women boxers younger than 18 signed by at least one of the parents/legal guardians certifying that the boxer is not pregnant)
- ➢ Anti-doping consent forms signed by all of the boxers
- ➢ Video consent form
- Image rights consent form
- ➢ Red and Blue uniform examples

10.2Each Team Delegation must bring the following:

- ➢ National flag 1 x 1.5m
- ➢ National anthem on MP3 or CD



10.3Boxer's Uniform:





- Each Boxer must bring two sets of uniform (complete red and blue color sets not being mixed with any other color)
- Boxers must wear a same color set of either red or blue form-fitting vest and shorts/skirts as per the Boxers' respective corner allocation which will be their own responsibility
- The belt line of any shorts/skirts must be clearly indicated by a contrasting color and by using a 6-10cm wide elastic waistband (the belt line is an imaginary line from the navel to the top of the hips).
- Bring Hair-net/bandana (for boxers with long hair)

11.OFFICIAL BOXING EQUIPMENT

All official boxing equipment for the ASBC Asian Elite Men and Women Boxing Championships Bangkok 2019 will be provided by AIBA Official Licensee.

12.MEDALS

- > ASBC and the Local organizing committee will distribute for each of the ten weight categories:
- > 1st Place : gold medal (1)
- ➤ 2nd Place : silver medal (1)
- ➤ 3rd Place : bronze medal (1)
- ➤ 4th Place : bronze medal (1)

13.ACCREDITATION

13.1.For Team Delegations

All Team Delegation members (as listed in 3) who registered for the ASBC Asian Elite Men and Women Boxing Championships Bangkok 2019 through AIBA Database by March 19, 2019 will receive their accreditation after the accommodation payment has been approved.







13.2.For National Federation Members :

Each National Federation has the possibility to request up to ten (10) extra accreditations for its internal needs and VIP by completing the accreditation request form in annex and send it back to ASBC and info@thailandboxing.or.th no later than March 19, 2019

14.INSURANCE

All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance as the LOC will provide liability insurance for all participants only at the Competition Venue.

15.MEDICAL CARE

The LOC will provide medical care and first-aid during the entire Championships Period to any participant who suffers from a sports injury contracted during the Championships.

16. Doping Control

There will be a $\mbox{ Anti}$ -doping test in this championship will be implemented as per WADA Regulation
