5. Rules of the Tournament:

- 5.1 In accordance with the latest Rules of AIBA and supervised by Technical Officials, the tournament will be staged in:
 - 8 Weight Categories for Men: 49kg, 52kg, 56kg, 60kg, 64kg, 69kg, 75kg, 81kg, 91kg, +91kg.
 - 5 Weight Categories for Women: 51kg, 57kg, 60kg, 69kg, 75kg.
- 5.2 The bouts for Elite Men will be 3 rounds of 3 minutes duration with a 1 minute rest between rounds. Headgear will be not allowed.
- 5.3 The bouts for Elite Women will be 3 rounds of 2 minutes duration with a 1 minute rest between rounds.
- 5.4 A "Ten Point Must-System" will be used in all bouts.
- 5.5 AIBA Affiliated Associations being invited in good standing are eligible to send ONE senior boxer between the age 19 and 40 (born between January 1, 2000 and December 31, 1979) to participate in the competition at each category.



5.6 Each boxer shall bring his and her own AIBA Record Book with Annual Medical Check duly completed to the weigh-in, Medical Examination and Non-pregnancy Form in the General Weigh-in.

6. Judges / Referees

Each team may be accompanied by one AIBA R&J (at least AIBA 1 star) whose accommodation costs will be covered by LOC.

7. Teams:

7.1 Boxers:

Each team can send maximum 15 boxers to participate in the competition.

7.2 Number of Team Officials:

Each country can send the following number of officials in their delegation:

1-5 boxer	1 official and 1 coach
6-10 boxers	1 official and 2 coaches
11-15 boxers	1 official and 3 coaches

In addition, each team may be accompanied by one team doctor.

7.3 The host will send two teams to participate in the competition.

8. Financial Conditions:

8.1 Team Delegates:

80US \$/ per / day for their accommodation and full board in single room, or 60US \$/ per / day for the accommodation and full board in double room.

8.2 Extra Delegates – who are over the number of the official delegation:
100 US \$/ per / day for their accommodation and full board in single room,
or 80 US \$/ per / day for the accommodation and full board in double room.



8.3 Only on-site payment in CASH by US Dollar will be accepted.

9. Boxing Equipment

Boxers are requested to bout with the boxing gloves, headgears (no headgears for Elite Men's) and hand bandages manufactured by one of the AIBA Official Boxing Equipment Licensees which will be provided by Organizing Committee.

10. Transportation

10.1 International Transportation

All the delegates will be welcomed at Shanghai International Airport. Round trip transportation from the respective country to and from Shanghai city shall be the responsibility of the participating associations.

10.2 Local Transportation

LOC will provide the transportation among Shanghai International Airport, hotels and the competition /training site.

11. Medical Care

The organizing committee will provide first-aid medical treatment for all participants who sustain sport injury during the entire event.

12. Insurance:

All participants are requested to provide their own travel and medical insurance.

13. Medals and Prize:

13.1 Medals

Gold, Silver and 2 (two) Bronze Medals, Diplomas will be awarded to the winners in each weight category.

13.2 Prize Money

Gold Medalists: 1000 USD each



Silver Medalists: 500 USD each

Bronze Medalists: 300 USD each

14. Training Facility:

The Organizing Committee will provide required training facilities.

15. Requirements:

All boxers must bring along with them:

- Record Book with Annual Up-to-date Certification

- Passport

Each National Federation Team must bring:

-National/Regional Flags 2.40x 1.60 m

-National/Regional Anthem (on MP3, CD or Cassette Tape)

16. Visa

The Organizing Committee will provide all the necessary facilities for all the participants to enter China. To ensure and speed up the visa application process, please email the passport scan copy of each person to LOC at <u>external.affairs@chnboxing.org.cn</u> no later than April 20, 2019. Based on it, LOC will issue an official visa support form to each delegation which will ensure your delegate to get the visa.
