3.1.Participating Boxers

- Elite Men & Women boxers between the age of 19 and 40 according to their year of birth (born between 2004 – 1983) will be eligible to compete in the following categories:
46 kg - 48 kg, 51kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63.5kg, 67 kg, 71kg, 75 kg, 80 kg, 86kg, 92kg, +92kg
- Youth Men & Women boxers between the age of 17 and 18 according to their year of birth (born between 2005 - 2006) will be eligible to compete in the following categories:
46 kg - 48 kg, 51kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63.5kg, 67 kg, 71kg, 75 kg, 80 kg, 86kg, 92kg, +92kg
- Junior Men & Women boxers between the age of 17 and 18 according to their year of birth (born between 2007 - 2008) will be eligible to compete in the following categories:
44 kg - 46 kg, 48 kg, 50 kg, 52 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63 kg, 66 kg, 70 kg, 75 kg, 80 kg and +80 kg

3.2 Team Officials

Each Team can have the following number of Team Officials:

Team Manager	: 01
Team Physician	: 01
Physiotherapist	: 01
Extra Person	: Open

Number of coaches according to below table:

1-3Boxers	: Up to 2 coaches
4-7 Boxers	: Up to 3 Coaches
8-10Boxers	: Up to 4 Coaches
11-30Boxers	: Up to 5 coaches

Each Boxer must bring an official proof of identity (identity or passport) in addition to (2) personal photos

3.3 Coaches and R&J s

- Each Boxer will be entitled to be accompanied to the ring by up to three (3) Coaches.
- Only two (2) Coaches may mount the apron of the ring and only one (1) may enter the ring.
- All boxers must be accompanied by at least one UAEBF certified coach at ringside during the bouts.
- All Coaches allowed to work in the Field of Play (FOP) must be UAEBF certified .
- If any team does not have a UAEBF certified coach, please raise this at the Technical Meeting so arrangements can be made with another team.

4. TOURNAMENT SYSTEM

- The fight will be stopped in the event that the Boxer obtains three counts in the same round (men and youth categories) or four counts in the fight for the Junior category.
- The Bouts are conducted with 10 oz or 12oz gloves, and the headguard is mandatory for the youth & Junior category only.
- Each team is entitled to participate with one player by weight, provided that the percentage of Local Boxers is 50% of the percentage of resident players. Any team that does not have a percentage of Local Boxers within the proposed percentage will not be accepted, provided that the children of female citizens are treated as citizens.
- The Resident Boxers must bring an Emirates ID card and the health insurance card
- In the event that any forgery is proven, the player and the team manager bear the responsibility, and his results are expunged, and appropriate penalties are taken against him.
- It is not permissible in any way to object to the Result.
- The Boxer who is disqualified does not get a medal and will not be awarded.
- A computer system or Paper sheet will be conducted to officiate the bouts.
- The Technical Delegate of the tournament is responsible for the technical aspects.
- The Competitions Committee is responsible for the tournament in terms of administrative and organizational aspects.
- The Technical Committee is responsible for the weigh-in and Draw.
- Each Boxer must bring personal Guards protection equipment and bandages.
- The Technical Committee is responsible for the weigh-in and Draw.
- Each Boxer must bring personal Guards protection equipment and bandages.
- The first winner will receive a gold medal and a financial prize, the second winner will receive a silver medal, and the third winner will receive a bronze medal.
- Otherwise, the IBA Technical & Competition Rules shall be applied
- The UAE Boxing Federation's Head Coach has the authorization to decline any unqualified boxers based on his level .
