3. ELIGIBILITY OF BOXER AND AGE CLASSIFICATION

The competition is open for boxers 13 to 14 years old (born between 2010 and 2011), 15 to 16 years old (born between 2008 and 2009), 17 to 18 years old (born between 2006 and 2007).

The tournament will be held according to the rules of IBA, in the following weight categories:

Schoolgirls:

38kg, 40kg, 42kg, 44kg, 46kg, 48kg, 51g, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 64kg, 70kg

Schoolboys:

40kg, 42kg, 44kg, 46kg, 48kg, 50kg, 52kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 63kg, 66kg, 70kg, 75kg, 80kg, 90kg

Junior girls and boys:

46kg, 48kg, 50kg, 52kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 63kg, 66kg, 70kg, 75kg, 80kg, +80kg

Youth boys:

48kg, 51kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 63,5kg, 67kg, 71kg, 75kg, 80kg, 86kg, 92kg, +92kg

Youth girls:

48kg, 50kg, 52kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 63kg, 66kg, 70kg, 75kg, 81kg, +81kg

4. COMPOSITION OF OFFICIAL DELEGATION:

Each Team Delegation can have the following number of officials:

1 – 5 Boxers:	2 coaches + 1 R/J + 1 official
6 – 15 Boxers:	3 coaches + 1 R/J + 1 official
16 or more Boxers:	4 coaches + 1 R/J + 2 official

Registration regulations:

- National Member Federations can send more than one Boxer in each Weight Category
- The participants must have two sets of uniform (red and blue color sets) approved by IBA.
- Each boxer and each R/J must have his international IBA Record Book, as well as medical exams up to date.



- All Coaches must be IBA Certified Coaches and registered in the IBA Database as LOC will check each Coach's status at the time of registration. Without the appropriate IBA certification, Coaches will not be allowed to enter this competition.

Boxing Equipment:

LOC will provide its licensed boxing gloves to all Boxers for all Bouts. The gloves are compulsory official items which all Boxers must wear, as they will not be allowed to wear their personal ones.

- 10oz Gloves will be used Youth boys from Minimumweight category (48 kg) to Welterweight category (67kg)
- 12oz Gloves will be used Youth boys from Light-middleweight category (71kg) to Super Heavyweight category (+92kg).

Number of rounds:

- Schoolboys/girls: Three (3) rounds of one and half (1,5) minutes, one (1) minute rest between rounds
- Junior: Three (3) rounds of two (2) minutes, one (1) minute rest between rounds
- Youth: Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, one (1) minute rest between rounds

Scoring System:

IBA Scoring System, the 10-Point Must System, will be used.

Requirements:

All Boxers must bring along with them:

- Record book with annual medicals duly completed and updated
- Current and valid Passport

Each Team Delegation must bring the following:

- National flag 1x1.5 m
- National anthem (on MP3 or CD)

Boxer's Uniform:

- Each boxer must bring two sets of uniform.
- The colors of these two sets of uniform must be in accordance with IBA Technical and Competition Rules.

Financial conditions:

- The cost of accommodation, full board: daily 3 meals (except 06th of June when only dinner will be provided and 10th of June when only breakfast will be provided)
- The local transportation (to the competitions) in Eger will be covered by the organiser for the members of the official delegations.

ACCOMMODATION

A. Room Rates for Team Delegations are as follows:

For triple occupancy (3 persons/room, separate beds)	EUR 75 per person/day , including 3 meals
For double occupancy (2 persons/room - twin beds)	EUR 80 per person/day , including 3 meals
For single occupancy (1 person per room)	EUR 90 per person/day , including 3 meals

- Free WiFi connection, fitness center
- Optional accommodation in triple occupancy
- **Limited amount of single rooms available – first come – first served basis**

The room rates are provided for the tournament period only and apply from **May 12th to May 18th, 2024**. When filling in the Travel and Accommodation Form, team delegations must include their choice of hotel.

Extra persons – who are over the number of the official delegation – and teams arriving **earlier than the 12th of May or leaving later than the 18th of May** will have to pay **110 EUR / person / day** for their accommodation and full board.



**Payment of Hotel Room Charges:**

- All Team Delegations must pay the full room charges for the entire Tournament Period (May 12-18) at the time of arrival in cash (Euros only), or bank transfer.

Team Delegations will not be able to receive accreditation cards and hotel room keys if the payment is not made in full.

- Please note that the total amount of participants is based on the Final Entry form. If Delegations arrive with a smaller Delegation than previously indicated in the Final Entry **without notification prior to the event**, they are still responsible to pay for the difference in full as it is considered a “No Show”.

Transportation:

- All the participating teams have to cover their travel expenses to and from Budapest (those who wish to travel directly to Eger have to cover the travel expenses to and from Eger).
- The transfer Budapest Airport - Eger - Budapest Airport (2x145 km) will be provided by the organizers at a cost of **20 EUR/person**.

Insurance:

- All participants are requested to get their own travel and medical insurance.
- LOC strongly recommends to each participant to have „European Health Insurance Card”.

Visa: The LOC will grant assistance to all delegations on visa matters.

Registration deadlines:

- Numerical preliminary entries must be sent to the Hungarian Boxing Association (hungarian@boxing.hu) until the **15th of April 2024**
- Nominal entries with names, date of birth, travel details and room request until the **25th of April 2024** (hungarian@boxing.hu)
